

# World Sleep 2022 Young Investigator and CG Award Application

**Note:** This application submits your consideration for both the **Young Investigator Awards** and the **Christian Guilleminault Young Investigator Awards**. The process, requirements, and deadlines are the same. You only need to submit this form once to be considered for both awards.

#### Overview of Awards

**Young Investigator Awards:** Young Investigator Awards will be offered to both oral abstract presenters and poster presenters. Oral abstract awards will provide the opportunity for up to 18 individuals to present their abstract during a special young investigator oral abstract session. Poster awards will be presented to up to 24 authors of the top ranked young investigator poster abstracts.

Oral abstract award winners will be granted complimentary registration and a travel grant of up to \$1000 USD (depending on distance of travel) to give a 10-minute oral presentation during a special oral abstract session of the congress.

Poster abstract award winners will be granted \$500 USD.

**Christian Guilleminault Young Investigator Awards**: Up to two awards of \$1000 USD will be awarded to qualifying individuals. Recipients will be recognized during the Opening Ceremony of the congress.

Requirements: 35 years old or younger OR less than 5 years post MD or PhD degree.

Deadline: November 30, 2021

### **Review Process**

The young investigator awards will be selected from submitted abstracts. Abstracts submitted by award applicants will be evaluated in two phases:

**Phase 1** (General abstract review): Award applicants will be notified of their acceptance for an oral or poster presentation. Acceptance of an oral or poster abstract **does not** imply the author will be selected to receive a young investigator award.

**Phase 2** (Young Investigator Award abstract review): Following the November 30, 2021 deadline, the applications will be reviewed, and award recipients will be notified by December 31, 2021.
